Tuition Savings for Out-of-State Students

Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania is pleased to provide a tuition savings opportunity for qualified out-of-state undergraduate students. The Non-Resident Tuition Reduction Program is designed to make SRU a more affordable college choice for academically-talented students. The tuition reduction currently amounts to a savings of over \$5,300 off the total regular out-of-state tuition cost per year to bring annual tuition and fees to approximately \$9600 per year for qualified students.

ELIGIBILITY

U.S. Citizens who are residents of states other than Pennsylvania may be eligible for a Non-Resident Tuition Reduction. Full-time SRU students who are pursuing their first bachelor's degree and who are billed at the regular undergraduate non-resident tuition rate will be considered for this program. No separate application is required. Eligibility is determined on an annual basis.

Eligibility for new SRU students will be determined through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions based upon a student's prior academic record. Official eligibility will be determined based upon a student's final official transcript as received by the Office of Admissions. The final official transcript must be received prior to the start of the semester in which the student enters SRU. Students may be notified of potential eligibility by the Financial Aid Office based upon the QPA listed on the transcripts on file at the time of the offer of admission to SRU. Qualified students will receive the reduction for a full academic year.

- New freshmen must have a 3.0 cumulative high school QPA on a 4.0 scale listed on their final official high school transcript as received by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. This includes all coursework from grades 9–12. In the absence of a 4.0 scale, eligibility will be determined based upon a B average as defined by the high school or by the use of a standard QPA conversion.
- New transfer students with 12 or more college credits earned must have a 3.0 cumulative QPA on all post-secondary coursework. Transfer students with fewer than 12 credits earned will be evaluated based on their high school records.

Eligibility for continuing SRU students will be determined through the Office of Financial Aid based upon a student's academic record at SRU. Initial eligibility will be determined after the Spring semester. Final eligibility will be determined at the start of the Fall semester.

- Continuing undergraduate students must have a 3.0 SRU QPA and must have earned at least 24 new credits in the prior academic year to receive or renew this award in subsequent years.

NOTIFICATION of the NON-RESIDENT TUITION REDUCTION

Students who demonstrate eligibility (or potential eligibility if final official transcripts are not yet received) for the Non-Resident Tuition Reduction will receive an award letter from the Financial Aid Office during the summer identifying the value of the tuition reduction. The billing statement generated by the Office of Student Accounts will reflect the regular out-of-state tuition charges along with a credit in the amount of the Non-Resident Tuition Reduction. As stated above, final eligibility will be determined at the start of the semester for current students or upon the receipt of the final official transcript for new students.

Students who do not meet eligibility requirements for the current academic year can become eligible for the reduction in subsequent academic years if they meet the eligibility criteria for continuing students.
